"Old Sawbones": Civil War Medicine

Tonight we will be treated to a special presentation by one of our own! **Jeanne Cox** is a current—and enthusiastic—member of the Mahoning Valley Civil War Round Table who hails from the great state of West Virginia. She has been a nurse since 1997; she worked in dialysis for nine years and has been a nurse practitioner for the past ten years

at Convenient Care in Calcutta, Ohio, which is part of the Heritage Valley Health System.

Jeanne's presentation will include a general overview of the state of medicine in the 1860s, focusing on the development of Civil War medicine at the beginning of the war, and she will discuss how wounded soldiers were medically treated on the battlefield as well as the role of the United States Colored Troops (USCT) in medical evacuations from the battlefield.
