Post-traumatic stress disorder is a term we are all too familiar with today; but PTSD was unheard of and soldiers' mental health issues went largely unacknowledged during the Civil War. Soldiers faced many horrors in battle and each soldier dealt with their own experiences differently. After the war, many soldiers could not cope with their difficult memories and the changes in America.
