The First Battle of Kernstown



Tonight we'll take a detailed look at the First Battle of Kernstown, a rare tactical defeat for Confederate Major

General Thomas J. "Stonewall" Jackson, which took place on March 23, 1862, in Winchester and Frederick County, Virginia. Guest speaker **Charles "Chuck" Maurer** will focus on the numerous Ohio units that took part in this small but very sharp battle from early in the American Civil War.

Chuck is a retired Army officer and Department of the Army civilian with a History Education degree from Bowling Green State University in Ohio. He has volunteered at numerous Civil War-related venues over the past 25 years, including: the Casemate Museum of Fort Monroe in Hampton, Virginia; Pamplin Historical Park and Blandford Church (a Confederate war memorial) in Petersburg, Virginia; and the Cool Spring and Kernstown battlefields in the lower Shenandoah Valley. He joined the Kernstown Battlefield Association, based in Winchester, Virginia, in 2018 and currently serves on its board of directors as chair of the Historical and Education Committee. He is also one of Kernstown's leading battlefield guides and a docent at the Pritchard-Grim farmhouse.

Chuck will include a brief overview of the Kernstown Battlefield Association and the Kernstown Battlefield / Historic Farm.
